

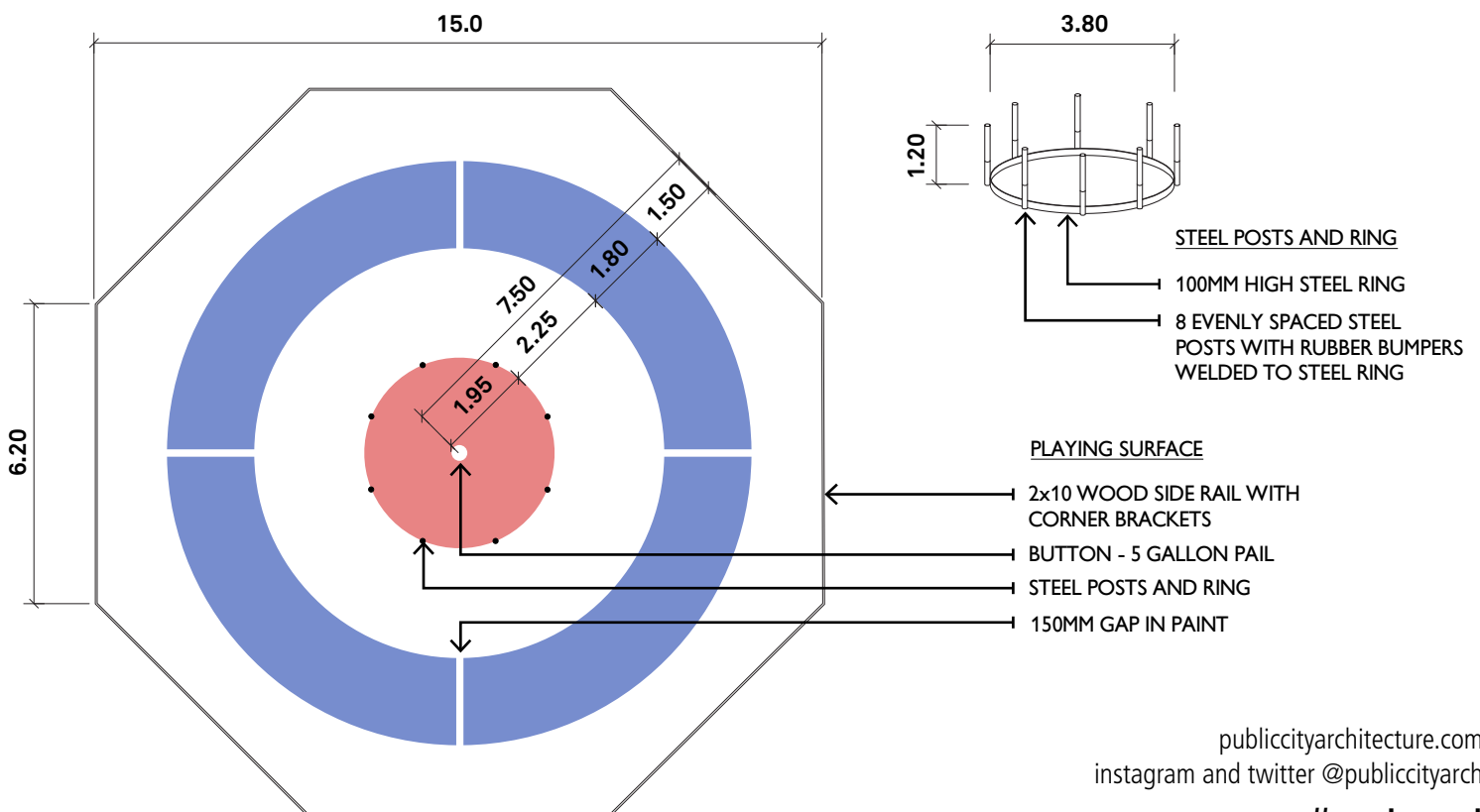
CROKICURL

HOW WE MADE IT

- select a site on level ground
- construct welded steel post and ring assembly - see drawing below
- construct 2x10 wood side rail - reinforce corners with steel brackets
- place steel posts and ring in center of playing surface - align posts as shown in drawing below
- use gravel fill to level surface as necessary
- place 5 gallon pail in center of playing surface, fill with removable weight
- ice the playing surface to a level that covers the steel ring
- paint scoring circles onto ice - see drawing below
- cut off exposed top of 5 gallon pail, fill bottom with water leaving 150mm depth for curling rock
- wrap bottom 300mm of steel posts with rubber mat to create post bumpers
- rejoice at the combination of crokinole and curling

SUPPLIES

- 50 linear metres of 2x10 lumber
- steel corner brackets
- gravel fill
- 5 gallon pail for center button
- steel posts and ring - see drawing below
- 2 contrasting paint colours - red and blue
- paint rollers and trays
- rubber mat for post bumper
- a level
- ice
- 8 outdoor junior curling rocks - 2 colors
